Dear Senior Parents,

It's the beginning of a new and exciting year here at Marian! Your daughter will be graduating soon, and the 2015-2016 yearbook staff would like to invite you to honor your daughter with a tribute photo and note in the ads section of her last Marian yearbook.

Inside you will find a sample page from last year's book and an order form. If you haven't had a chance to check out last year's yearbook, we highly encourage you to do so for ideas. The ads are found on pages 218-243. We ask you to limit your ad to one picture of your daughter, keeping to the baby or toddler timeline. We also ask that your daughter be fully dressed and suggest she is the only one in the photo. The ad message should be short and sweet. It can be sentimental, but try to not use copyrighted lyrics.

Please have your order form in by October 15, 2015 for the discounted price. The final deadline is December 1, 2015. Any order forms sent in after the December deadline will not be accepted. In order to maintain our printing contract with our yearbook printer, we must enforce this deadline.

If you are sending a photo via regular mail, place your daughter's name and address on the back of the picture. An address label works great for that purpose. This photo will be returned to you as soon as the proofs of the pages come back from the printer. We will try our best to keep all Senior Ads a secret from your daughter, unless you choose to share it with her ahead of time.

If you would prefer to email the photo and ad message to us, please use the addresses found in the last paragraph below. Please make sure the photos are at least 300 dpi. Also, you will still need to send in the order form and payment to Marian by the postmark deadlines. We cannot accept credit card payments at this time.
